Scholarships listed below require the EVW Scholarship Application. Please see Google Classroom for a link to the application.

American Legion Post 381 - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students. However, preference is given to a student who has demonstrated their pride in Americanism. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

AM Maus - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to EVW students who are pursuing a career as an Auto Technician. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

American Red Cross Blood Drive Scholarship - Several scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students who have donated blood or assisted with the community blood drives.

Arthur Lahr Memorial Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded. 1 scholarship available to all EVW students who were involved with FFA during high school; 1 scholarship available to all EVW students who will be pursuing a career in the agriculture field.

Buddy Kiehn Memorial - 1-2 scholarships awarded. Available to all EV-W students with preference given to student(s) who show financial need. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Carolyn Beecher Memorial Art Scholarship - 2 scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students who have taken one or more art classes in grades 9-12 and participated in art related shows, contests, or activities. Consideration will be given to students' academic achievement.

CentraCare; Paynesville - Dollars for Scholars - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to any EVW student who plans to pursue a healthcare career.

Christine Maul Memorial - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college.

Dale Mausehund Memorial - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who are pursuing a college education in agriculture or a related field. Student must hold an active leadership role in an agricultural related group, a GPA of 2.0 or greater, and complete a 500 word essay.

Donald B. Schlangen Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who plan to attend a 2 or 4 year college.

Eagle Boosters - 4 scholarships awarded; 2 male & 2 female recipients will be selected. Available to all EVW students who participate in extracurricular activities, not limited to honors students. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Eden Valley Lions - 4 scholarships awarded; 2 male & 2 female recipients will be selected. Available to students with Eden Valley, Grove City, Paynesville or Richmond addresses; preference will be given to students who have a demonstrated record of community service.

EE Machtmes – 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who have overcome some type of hardship (whether it be mental, physical, or emotional), who demonstrates an understanding of the value of education, and has the desire to succeed. This scholarship is designed to assist a student who has received special education or academic support services, but is not limited to those areas.

EVW 3 Sport Award – 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who have participated in Athletics throughout their High School career.

Fink Memorial Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students planning to pursue a career in agriculture or conservation.

Gaspar Family Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students planning to pursue a business career. If there are no students pursuing business, then the scholarship will be given out based on academic achievement.

Gordie Kramer & Brian Walz Memorial - 5 scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students who participate in extracurricular activities, have demonstrated all around outstanding citizenship with involvement in local community activities, and whose parents have volunteered with the Watkins Fire Department. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

In Memory of Jeffrey Schutz Scholarship – 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students who plan to pursue a career in Engine Mechanics, Automotive, Welding, or Trades.

Janelle Reetz - Eden Valley Fire & Rescue Scholarship – 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students pursuing a career in the Medical Field or Law Enforcement. Preference will be given to students pursuing Fire and Rescue. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Kadyl Logistics Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to any EVW student pursuing a career in Education.

Kathleen Marx-Supplee Scholarship - 1 renewable scholarship is awarded. Available to all EVW students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and intention to pursue a four-year nursing degree. The award (\$1,500) is renewable for four years, upon successful completion of nursing program prerequisites and/or nursing courses, while maintaining a college GPA of 3.0 or higher. Verification of enrollment and GPA will be required each consecutive year.

LeRoy H. Nolan Memorial Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students in good academic standing pursuing careers in accounting, math, or education.

Meeker Cooperative Electric Trust - 2 scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students who service electricity or internet through Meeker Cooperative and have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Nancy Voigt Memorial Scholarship - 1 Scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students pursuing agriculture or health fields.

National Honor Society - 3-5 scholarships awarded. Available to all EV-W NHS members.

Norbert & Mary Korman Memorial – 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students ranked in the top half of their class, actively working and saving for college, and showing involvement in community or school activities.

Royale B. and Eleanor M. Arvig Memorial Scholarship - 1 renewable scholarship is awarded. Available to all EVW students with a GPA of 2.0 or higher, exhibiting qualities of good citizenship, leadership, and academic ability. Students pursuing careers in math, engineering, telecommunications, accounting, computer science, or any other physical sciences to be given preference. The award (\$750) will be granted each year after successful completion of fall semester coursework.

Sarah Grunewald Memorial Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students with a GPA of 3.5 or higher, active in afterschool activities and volunteering, demonstrating financial need, and pursuing careers in medical, animal science, or education.

Student Council – Several scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students, but preference will be given to Student Council members.

Tri-M Honor Society Scholarship – Several scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students, but preference will be given to Tri-M members.

Watkins Chamber of Commerce Scholarship - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students with a Watkins address showing involvement in the community or ties to area businesses.

Community Scholarships

These scholarships require a separate application. Please see Sarah Geislinger for applications.

American Legion Auxiliary - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW female students with an Eden Valley address.

Eden Valley Hawks – 2 scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students with a 3.0 GPA and involvement in school athletics. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Eden Valley-Watkins Youth Basketball Association – 2 scholarships awarded; 1 male & 1 female recipient will be selected. Available to all EVW students with a 3.0 GPA or higher, involved in Basketball, with no MSHSL violations. To receive the scholarship award, proof of post-secondary enrollment is required.

Roberg Scholarship Trust - Several scholarships awarded. Available to students who are enrolled at ACGC, Dassel-Cokato, Eden Valley-Watkins, Hutchinson, Kimball, and Litchfield. These students are planning to attend a public college or vocational school. 3 factors considered: scholastic achievement, extra-curricular or community service.

Watkins Lions Scholarship - 4 scholarships awarded; 2 male & 2 female recipients will be selected. Available to all EVW students with a Watkins mailing address.

CommunityGiving Foundation Scholarships

These scholarships require an online application. Please visit www.communitygiving.org for applications.

Farmer & Merchant State Bank in Eden Valley - 1 scholarship awarded. Available to all EVW students whose parent or guardian IS NOT a current employee of F&M State Bank.

State Bank of Richmond Scholarship - 3 scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students residing in the Richmond community; applicants or their parents must live within a 15-mile radius of Richmond and/or have an account with the State Bank of Richmond.

Wat-Kim-Valley - Several scholarships awarded. Available to all EVW students. Students must reflect on the essence of leadership and being a role model in the required application essay.
