2022-23 World's Best Workforce Goals

A. Closing identified achievement gap(s)

EVW will reduce the proficiency gap between FRD and non-FRD populations of students enrolled by October 1 in grades 3-8 on Minnesota **reading** accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) from 8.9% in 2022 to 7% in 2023.

The proficiency gap between FRD and non-FRD populations of students enrolled by October 1 in grades 3-8 on Minnesota **math** accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) will be reduced from 9.1% in 2022 to 6.5% in 2023.

Goal Not Met: Proficiency gap between FRD and non-FRD in reading was 17.2%, and proficiency gap in math was 14.7%

B. All students ready for kindergarten

By the end of the 2022-2023 school year, 85% of students enrolled in our school readiness preschool program at EVW will be able to identify the sound of 13 or more letters of the alphabet.

Goal Partially Met: 74.5% of students could identify 13 or more letter sounds

C. All students in third grade achieving grade level literacy

The percentage of all students enrolled in grade 3 by October 1 at EVW who are proficient on Minnesota reading accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) will increase from 37.5% in 2022 to 55% in 2023. Goal Not Met: 38.5% of third graders were proficient on reading accountability tests

D. All students attaining career and college readiness before graduating from high school

The percentage of all students enrolled in grade 8 by October 1 at EVW who are proficient on Minnesota math accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) will increase from 49.4% in 2022 to 61% in 2023. This goal is continued from 2022.

Goal Not Met: 33.8% of eighth graders were proficient on math accountability assessments

E. All students graduate from high school

Eden Valley-Watkins High School will maintain the four-year graduation rate of 97%, which is well above the state average (with a minimum graduation rate at any point being 95%).

Goal Met: The preliminary graduation rate for 2023 was 98.6%
