

2024-25 Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness Goals

A. Closing identified achievement gap(s)

EVW will reduce the proficiency gap between FRD and non-FRD populations of students enrolled by October 1 in grades 3-8 on Minnesota **reading** accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) from 16.4% in 2024 to 14% in 2025.

The proficiency gap between FRD and non-FRD populations of students enrolled by October 1 in grades 3-8 on Minnesota **math** accountability tests (MCA, MTAS) will be reduced from 13.7% in 2024 to 11% in 2025.

B. All students ready for kindergarten

By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, 80% of students enrolled in our school readiness preschool program at EVW will be able to identify the sound of 13 or more letters of the alphabet.

C. All students attaining career and college readiness before graduating from high school

All students at EVW will pass the Junior/Senior seminar course before graduating from high school. The course covers college and career readiness topics such as managing finances, applying for jobs, college and career exploration, and completing Personal Learning Plans.

D. All students graduate from high school

Eden Valley-Watkins High School will maintain the four-year graduation rate of 95%, which is well above the state average.

E. Prepare students to be lifelong learners

By the end of the 2024-25 school year, 75% of students in grades 7-12 will show curiosity and a desire for lifelong learning and a willingness to explore a wide range of subjects and interests through the participation in school sponsored clubs, sports, or activities that are not part of our core, everyday schedule.
