Eden Valley-Watkins Secondary School is providing the option for on line course registration for 2018-2019. Through this opportunity, it is our hope that dialogue will occur at home in regards to the selection of possible classes for the upcoming school year. Within the following attachments, you will find:

1. the directions for completing online registration. Registration can occur any time from February 5th to February 19th.
2. the registration form for students entering Grade 8. The only choices to be made by these pupils are in regard to whether they will be in Band, Choir, Study¹Hall, or Honors English 8. All other courses are required.
3. the graduation requirements for students entering Grades 9-12.
4. semester course offerings for pupils entering Grade 9-12 for first and second semester. When registering it is recommended to select those courses that are required first and then fill the remainder of the schedule with desired electives.

Meetings will occur with students on Thursday, February 1st to discuss the registration process, distribute materials, and allow individuals time to develop tentative class schedules for next year. Registration guides have been emailed to students' school email accounts.

Any pupil without internet access at home or who does not register on line by the end of the day on February 19th will register with school personnel on Tuesday, February 20.

Online Registration

1. Login in <https://evw.powerschool.com/public/home.html> or many students use the Power Grade login on the evw.k12.mn.us website under the For Families tab.
2. Enter Username and Password
Students have their own username and password or parents can use theirs from the accounts they have set up.
3. On left side of screen, click on Class Registration
4. Welcome to EVW Class Registration
 1. Click on top pencil on right side of the screen.
 2. Follow directions at the top of screen-navigate through page numbers at bottom to find desired courses.
 3. When finished click okay.
 4. Proceed to next pencil. You are finished when green arrows follow pencils.

*New - The Civics Test goes into effect for students entering grade 9 in 2017-18 and later. According to HF 2749 "Students enrolled in a public school must correctly answer at least 30 of the 50 civics test questions... A district must not prevent a student from graduation... for failing to correctly answer 30 of 50 questions." Students at EVW will first be given an opportunity to pass the 50 point civics test in 9th grade. Another opportunity will be provided to students when taking the required American Government class offered in grades 10-12. A record of student achievement will be kept in the district assessment results file.

Graduation Requirements Overview 2018-2019 for Students in Grade 9-12

Students entering grades 9-12 must successfully complete the following course and credit requirements for graduation.

4 English Credits

- 1 year English 9
- 1 semester of Literature and Composition (2nd semester grade 10)
- 1 semester of Comp. II (1st semester grade 11)
- 1 semester of literature elective
- 1 semester of speech elective
- 1 semester of composition elective
- 1 semester of other English elective

4 Social Studies Credits

- 1 year American History 9
- 1 year of World History 10
- 1 semester of Geography
- 1 semester of American Government
- 1 semester of Economics or Ag Economics
- 1 semester of Social Studies elective

3 Science Credits

- 1 year Physical Science with Earth Science
- 1 year Biology
- 1 year Chemistry, Physics, Food Chemistry, Ag Mechanics/Physics

4 Math Credits

- 1 year Grade 9 (Algebra/Geometry Essentials, Algebra 1.5, or Geometry)
- 1 year Grade 10 (Algebra 1.5, Algebra 2, or Geometry)
- 1 year Grade 11 (Algebra 2, Algebra 3/Trigonometry, or Algebra/Geometry Essentials)
- 1 semester Grade 11 (Probability/Statistics)
- 1 year Grade 12 (College Algebra, Pre-Calculus)
- or minimum of 1 semester (Algebra Topics for Seniors, Math Finance for Seniors, or Introduction to Accounting)

1 1/2 Health/Physical Education Credits

- 1 semester of PE/Health 9
- 1 year of PE/Health 10

A minimum of 7 elective course credits must be earned for the Class of 2013 and beyond including at least 1 credit of Fine Arts. Possibilities for Fine Arts classes include: Computer Graphic Art, Advanced Art, Introduction to Everyday Art, 2D/3D Art (Mixed Media), 3-D Printing/Sculpture Art, Band, Choir, Drama, Media, and Oral Interpretation.
