

## P-EBT Benefits for the 2022-23 School Year

# Your child may be eligible for Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)

### School-aged students – in school

- Attend a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) or the Seamless Summer Option
- Submitted an application for educational benefits and are eligible for free or reduced-price meals
- Experienced reduced access to school meals due to a COVID-19 impact

### School-aged students – virtual or homeschool

- Attended a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) school after Jan. 27, 2020 (or would have attended if old enough to enter school)
- Attested that the child transferred to a homeschool or virtual option due to concerns about the COVID pandemic
- Contacted their local school district to get a student identification number for each child
- Submitted an application for P-EBT benefits for homeschool or virtual students to the local school and are eligible for free or reduced-price meals
