



Food is Available so Your Kids Can Focus on Learning

The Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) 2020-21 school year benefits will be coming soon! P-EBT is a temporary food benefit to families with children who would have received free and reduced-price meals if schools were open.

NEW!

There is no separate P-EBT application needed this year. To qualify for P-EBT, your child must:

- Applied and qualified for Free and Reduced lunches this school year
- OR**
- Be enrolled in the SNAP, MFIP, or TANF
- AND**
- In a hybrid- or distance - learning format for the majority of the month.

Take action before February 28, 2021

- Make sure the school has your current address and contact information
- If you applied and qualified for Free and Reduced lunch this school year you do not need to do anything
- If you are on SNAP, MFIP, or TRIBAL TANF you do not need to do anything
